#### **Altar Guild**

When you enter the sanctuary, what catches your eye? The colorful paraments, the seasonal banners, the glowing candles, or the linen-covered bread and wine? Eventually, we are all drawn to the bread and wine as we prepare to receive the Lord's Supper. Every Saturday and Sunday, the bread and wine are carefully prepared for Holy Communion by three volunteers who serve once a month. Their Ministry, known as the Altar Guild. includes baking the bread, and placing the bread, the chalice, the pitcher of wine, and the individual wine cups on the Altar, draping everything in clean linens. From here we experience the Real Presence of Christ and express our unity in the Body of Christ through the Lord's Supper. After worship, these volunteers return everything to the Sacristy and clean up.
