New Property Projects!

Our Leadership Team voted to begin a threephase process to build an additional columbarium wall, then renovate the chapel and parking lot. Our goal is to build the next columbarium wall late summer or fall. Then work towards the chapel and parking lot next spring and summer. The team overseeing these projects will be Darell Zimbelman, Lesli Bruden, Ted Schmidt, Neil Pappas, with President Bryan French and Pastor as advisory members. Our property is getting older and needs upkeep to provide the ministries we desire and to keep people safe.

With the mortgage getting paid off in January 2026, several options for financing these projects are being considered. In addition we have monies in our Property Improvements monthly savings.

We want to inform you now and along every step of the way as we go out for bids and make decisions. This will require a congregational meeting as the projects are outside the current budget.

As new homes continue to be built on the west end of 29th near the park, we will have more and more traffic going right by the church. It is to our advantage to have curb appeal. Yet, in this day and age and more importantly, we need to increase our skills at inviting. Most people will not enter a church building if they have never been in one before and know nothing about the good news of Jesus. He told the disciples to go make fishers of men/women.
