Key Responsibilities

- Champion and cultivate a culture of safety across all levels of the organization
- Conduct regular safety inspections of job sites, facilities, and company vehicles
- Oversee and update pre-hire physical testing requirements to ensure job relevance and legal compliance
- Develop, distribute, and monitor completion of toolbox talks
- Lead monthly safety meetings and ensure follow-up on action items
- Prepare and submit OSHA-required reports both annually and as incidents arise
- Investigate safety incidents thoroughly and prepare detailed documentation and root cause analyses
- Manage workers' compensation claims in coordination with HR
- Conduct and document new hire safety training and onboarding
- Deliver ad hoc safety training sessions as needed
- Maintain up-to-date Job Hazard Analyses (JHAs) for job sites
- Monitor and maintain first aid kits and safety equipment inventory
- Coordinate CPR, First Aid, and fire extinguisher training and compliance
- Source and manage medical providers for all job sites
- Oversee PPE selection, purchasing, and distribution
- Develop and communicate emergency standard operating procedures (SOPs)
- Complete all safety-related components of customer and project pre-qualification documentation
