

# Medicare Enrollment Checklist

## **1. Six months before the month that you turn 65.**

- ✓ If you plan on enrolling in **Original Medicare** (parts A and B ) **WITH** a Medicare Supplement, you can enroll in your Medicare Supplement **at this time.**
- ✓ The advantage to this is that you will lock in your premium and not be subject to any rate increases for **18 months.**
- ✓ My advice is to contact a **Medicare Professional** to help you with this process so that you will be informed of all the options available.

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## **2. Three months before the month that you turn 65**

✓ If you are **not automatically** enrolled in Medicare parts A and B, **NOW** is the time to do this. There are three ways to do this.

1) visit your local social security office and enroll

2) call social security at **1-800-772-1213** and enroll by phone.

3) enroll on line at [www.ssa.gov/medicare/](http://www.ssa.gov/medicare/)

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### **3. Three months before the month that you turn 65**

- ✓ If you are planning on enrolling in a **Medicare Advantage Plan**, instead of **Original Medicare** you may do so at this time.
  - **Medicare Advantage** is another way to receive Medicare coverage.
  - There are pros and cons to consider when deciding between **Original Medicare** and **Medicare Advantage**.
  - Contact your **Medicare Professional** to see which option might be best for you.

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## **4. Three months before the month that you turn 65**

- ✓ If you have decided on **Original Medicare**, now is the time to enroll in your **Medicare Part D** (prescription drug coverage).

### **There are three ways to do this.**

- 1)** Go to [www.medicare.gov/find-a-plan/](http://www.medicare.gov/find-a-plan/) fill in the information and enroll on line.
- 2)** Call **Medicare** directly at **1-800-633-4227** and enroll on the phone.
- 3)** Contact your **Medicare Professional** and see what plan is best for you.

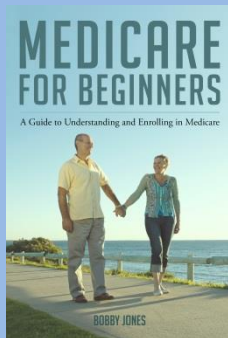
