



Please review the C2 tie-breaker rules below for the Boys U14 and Boys U15 final Matches on October 24th and 25th.

Tiebreaker Rules

1. **Head-to-Head Competition** - The results of the games played only among the three tied teams are used first.
 - Points - determine the number of points earned by each team in matches between the tied teams.
 - Goal Difference - if teams are still tied, the team with the greater goal difference in matches between the tied teams is ranked higher.
 - Goals scored - if still tied, the team that scored more goals in the matches between them is ranked higher.

2. **All Group Matches** - if the tie is not broken, the process repeats using the results from all group matches.
 - Goal Difference - the team with the greater goal difference across all group matches is ranked higher.
 - Goals scored - If still tied, the team that scored more goals in all group matches is ranked higher.

3. **Final Tiebreakers** - If a tie still exists, the following criteria may be used
 - Penalty Kicks - a penalty shootout will be performed after every match to determine the final ranking in case of a tie.
 - Drawing of lots (coin toss) - if a tie persists, the final decision will be made by a coin toss
