**GETTY GEORGE III  
COMMUNITY SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA**

1. The Getty George III Community Service Scholarship is awarded to graduating seniors who will be attending a trade school or college. Applicants are expected to be involved in outreach activities in their community, beyond school activities.
2. One (1) \$2,500 scholarship may be awarded to a graduating senior in the Alvord Unified School District.
3. Must have a 3.0 GPA or better.
4. **Applicants must have performed exceptional voluntary service for the betterment of their community** such as: Alvord Educational Foundation, Salvation Army, Senior Center, Citrus Historical Park, Library, Habitat for Humanity, Special Olympics, etc. Student must be an active participant, not an observer and receive no compensation of any kind for their activities. Preference will be given to service special needs individuals or for the betterment of the community in one or more of the following categories: Social Service, Historic Preservation, Children's Activities, Civic Pride & Awareness of the Arts in our Community.
5. Volunteer service must be outlined in the application and **be verified. Please submit a log or other form of verification including dates, hours, location, service performed, etc.** It must have a clear signature and printed name of supervisor and their contact information for each group/activity.
6. Completed scholarship form, essay, Community Service log/verification, 1 basic letter of recommendation and **official high school transcript** should be submitted together. **One additional letter of recommendation** acknowledging the primary community service & verifying the activity and hours is also **required for this scholarship**. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
7. Winners of the Community Service Award will not be eligible to receive a basic AEF scholarship.

**ROSEMARY BROCK  
TEACHING SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA**

One (1) \$2000 scholarship may be awarded to one (1) graduating senior in the Alvord Unified School District.

The following criteria must be met in order to receive the Rosemary Brock Teaching Scholarship. If you are applying for this particular scholarship please read carefully and ensure that you meet each specific requirement in order to be considered to receive this scholarship.

1. The Rosemary Brock Teaching Scholarship is awarded to one (1) graduating senior who will be attending college with the goal of becoming a certificated classroom teacher. Applicants are expected to be involved in outreach activities in their community, beyond school activities.
2. One (1) \$2000 scholarship may be awarded to one senior student in the Alvord Unified School District.
3. Must have a 2.5 GPA or better and be accepted and plan to attend a 4 year college/university to prepare for a Bachelor's Degree and State Teacher's Certification.
4. The student must meet all the requirements for a basic AEF scholarship at the date of application.
5. Volunteer service that emphasizes working with tutoring, assisting students at other schools or other actual teaching activities will give the student additional consideration.
6. Volunteer service must be outlined in the application and must be verified. **SUBMIT A LOG** or other form of verification including dates, hours, location, service performed, etc. It must have a clear signature and printed name of supervisor and their contact information for each group/activity.
7. Completed Standard AEF scholarship form, essay, Community Service log/verification, 1 basic letter of recommendation and official SEALED high school transcript should be submitted together. **One additional letter of recommendation** acknowledging the student's focus on activities and characteristics that are related to teaching is also required for this scholarship. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
8. The recipient of the Teaching Scholarship **will not** be eligible to receive a basic AEF scholarship.
