**Together Time:** This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Various learning centers, table activities, and toys are available to explore. Staff are available to provide information regarding your child's development, parenting information, community resources and more. Program staff will lead a circle time at the end.

**Friends at Play:** This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. This program gives children and caregivers a chance to explore the toys in the program room. Caregivers are encouraged to play with their child.

**Gym Time:** This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. |The gym is set up with toys to promote gross motor development.

**Rainbow Fun:** This is a interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Children and their caregivers will be encouraged to participate in gross motor games, songs and activities.

**Play, Learn & Connect:** An interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. This program gives families an opportunity to play in a safe and engaging environment to explore and learn through play. Parents and caregivers can connect with others for social and community support. Program staff will lead circle time at the end.

**Babies at Play:** This is a interactive program for families with children ages birth to 18 months. Baby toys and sensory activities will be provided along with songs and finger plays to stimulate and enhance your baby's development.

**Baby Music:**This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 18 months. Families with babies will gather together and sing songs, learn rhymes and use a variety of props and materials.

**Kids Club:** is a childcare that is provided for parent/caregiver who are attending a baby program and/or workshop. No registration is required. Staff will enroll the child once acceptance to the program has been confirmed.

**Reading Partnership for Parents Online Program:** is a 10-week virtual play-based program that guides parents through the process of teaching their children (ages 4 to 6) to read. It equips them with the skills, tools and confidence to improve their children's literacy levels by fostering positive reading and learning environments at home.

**Let's Talk About ...Toileting workshop:** is a toilet training workshop with a child therapist from Strides Toronto! Learn signs of readiness, how to build a schedule, and tips to support your child's potty training journey. Limited spots available-register online or at Orchard Park front desk.

## **Galloway: PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS**

**Gym Time:** This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. The gym is set up with toys to promote gross motor development.

**Muffins with Mom:** Celebrate Mother's Day during Gym Time on May 9th with a muffin treat and special crafts for the important women in your child's life.

**Cooking Together:** This is a pre-registered program for families who have children ages 2-4 years old. Each week participants will engage in fun and nutritious cooking activities along with crafts and story time.

**Happiest Toddler workshop:** This workshop focuses on a totally new and extraordinarily effective way to communicate with our little toddlers. Through video, Dr. Harvey Karp will teach us how to calm outbursts, stop 60 -90% of tantrums before they happen and build a loving and respectful relationship with the young child you work with. Some preliminary theory on behaviour management will be introduced.
