Child Care Worker

Our Licensed Child Care Centres are seeking a Child Care Worker who is enthusiastic and passionate about working with children from 18 months to 12 years. The primary role of the Child Care Worker is to support the RECE in planning and implementing a high-quality Play-and-Inquiry Based Summer Program that meets the various needs of the children. Major responsibilities include observation documentation, program planning, setting up programs, and implementing learning experiences. The Child Care Worker will be required to attend a week of training before beginning their employment.

Program Responsibilities:

- Support RECE in observation documentation and program planning
- Implement a daily program in accordance with the weekly program plan
- Prepare and set up learning experiences according to the daily program plan
- Actively engage children in daily learning experiences
- Support children in self-regulation and problem solving
- Greet and maintain positive communications with parents and guardians
- Maintain a clean, healthy, and safe environment for children
- Other duties as assigned
