Together Time: This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Various learning centers, table activities, and toys are available to explore. Music Makers: This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Families are invited to join this music circle and participate in new and familiar songs & rhymes.

Cognitive Toddlers: This is an interactive program for families with children ages 18 to 30 months. This program focuses on providing opportunities to learn through play and promotes cognitive, language and social development.

Gym Time: This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. The gym is set up with toys to promote gross motor development.

All About Me: This is an interactive program for families with children ages 2.6 to 4. This program focus' on teaching children about themselves, their family, home, culture, traditions, friends, pets and more!

Reading Partnership for Parents (RPP): is a 10-week virtual* play-based program that guides parents through the process of teaching their children (ages 4 to 6) to read. It equips them with the skills, tools and confidence to improve their children's literacy levels by fostering positive reading and learning environments at home. Participating families receive over \$200 worth of learning tools and resources. *You will need a device that connects to the internet, as well as a microphone and camera to participate in the program.

Let's Talk About...Toileting: This workshop will help parents decide if their child is ready for toilet training. Parents will also learn a simple and effective program they can introduce that builds on their child's success. Helpful resources such as books and videos are also discussed. Handouts will be provided.

I'm a Big Kid Now! Encourage Your Child to be More Independent: Is your child timid? Is he/she highly dependent on you? Does your child have difficulty separating from you? Are you worried about adjustment to kindergarten? If you have answered yes to any of these questions, you may want to join this parent session for some supportive discussions about how to foster independence.

Healthy Eating, Food and Mood: "We are what we eat". Healthy eating is essential for overall health. In this workshop, participants will be introduced to the relationship between food and mood. Parents/caregivers will be able to identify common foods that support positive mood using the Canada's Food Guide, understand how mood can effect your food choices and apply concepts of mindful eating to make mealtimes with young children less stressful.
