Orchard Park: PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

(Note: All are welcome to participate. No registration required.)

Together Time is for children 0-6 years and their parent and/or caregiver. Various learning centres are available for families to engage and play in. Program staff will lead circle time, where we all gather together to sing songs, and may include a story.

Highland Creek Library: Music & Movement is an interactive program designed for families and their children ages birth to 6 years old. We welcome families and children, focusing on bouncing babies and terrific toddlers! Parents will become familiar with children's songs and actions. Speech and language development will be promoted through songs and finger-plays.

Music Makers is for children 0-6 and their parent and/or caregiver. Each week, participants will learn new songs along with some favourites. This program promotes language development through songs, music and movement, and play.

Friends at Play is for children 0-6 years and their parent and/or caregiver. Various activities will be made available in our 1 program room for families to engage in together.

Cognitive Toddlers is for children 24-36 months and their parent and/or caregiver. Toddlers will be given opportunities to learn through play and promotes cognitive, language, and social development.

Baby Music is for babies birth to 18-months. Parent and/or caregiver will become familiar with children's songs. Speech and language development will be promoted through songs and finger plays. This program promotes bonding with your baby.

Fun with Letters is for children age 2 to 5 years old and their parent and/or caregiver. Children will focus on letter and sound recognition skills through various hands-on experiences such as creative arts, sensory, fine motor and gross motor activities.

Pre-K Practice is for children age 2.8 to 4 years old and their parent and/or caregiver. Children must be attending kindergarten in September 2023. Parents will work together with their children on fine motor skills (for writing and self help), social-emotional skills (making friends), language and cognitive skills (ABCs, 123s, etc.)

Kids Club is childcare that is provided for parent/caregiver who are attending the Baby Music program and/or any scheduled workshop. Space is limited, staff will enroll the child once your acceptance to the program has been confirmed.

French Fun is for children age 4 to 6 years old and their parent and/or caregiver. Children will be introduced to basic words and expressions in French. A variety of classroom activities will be implemented to help develop correct pronunciation and other oral communication skills.

Orchard Park: ADULT SERVICES

Reading Partnership for Parents Online: is a 10-week virtual play-based program that guides parents through the process of teaching their children (aged 4-6) to read. It equips them with the skills, tools and confidence to improve their children's literacy levels by fostering positive reading and learning environments at home.

Happiest Baby: is a workshop that focuses on the value of attachment in the early stages of infancy as well as new ways to calm a crying baby, which helps them to sleep longer. **Note:** This workshop will be taking place after our Baby Music program. Kid's Club will be extended until 12:00 p.m. due to the workshop.

Toilet Training: is a workshop that will help parents get through this important milestone by providing toilet training tips that will set their child up for success! Register now to learn the signs of readiness, how to create a toilet training schedule and how to access helpful resources that will help boost your child's interest to potty train. **Note:** Child minding for children 2+ years old is provided during this workshop.

Galloway: PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS
(Note: All are welcome to participate. No registration required.)

Gym Time: Gym Time is an interactive drop in program for children ages birth to 6 years and their parents/ caregivers. The gym will be set up with toys to promote gross motor activity. Toys include balls, slides, ride on cars, a baby area, and games. Please bring indoor running shoes.

ABC & Me: ABC & Me is a drop in program created for children ages 2-6 years old and their parents/ caregivers. It is a communication, language and literacy based program that focuses on specific domains and skills following the framework of Ontario early childhood settings (ELECT). Families will have the opportunity to take part in activities such as crafts, literacy exercises, and group games that help promote letter/sound recognition and support language development.

Math Made Easy: Math Made Easy is a drop in program for children ages 4 to 6 years old that will focus on developing mathematical and logical reasoning skills. Children will explore basic mathematical concepts through various exercises and activities.

Little Einstein: Little Einstein’s is a drop in program created for children ages 2-6 years old and their parents/caregivers. This program is an inquiry based program that focuses on specific domains and skills following the framework of Ontario early childhood settings (ELECT). Introducing a STEM enriched program that encourages kids to experiment, make mistakes and learn how to be critical thinkers and problem solvers. Families will have the opportunity to design and test experiments that provides a hands on experience to explore and discover.

Play N’ Learn: Play N' Learn is an interactive drop in program for children ages birth to 6 years and their parents/caregivers. The EarlyON space will be set up with toys to promote gross motor activity. Toys include balls, slides, ride on cars, a baby area, and games.

Circle of Friends: is an in-person program designed to support children who may require assistance or accommodations in order to participate in group programs. Participants do not need to have a diagnosis in order to attend this program. Join us as we engage in fun activities that have a focus on sensory and gross motor skills.

Mornelle: PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS
(Note: All are welcome to participate. No registration required.)

Together Time with Babies: This is an interactive drop in program. Babies will explore activities using their senses , enjoy family time with parents, teachers and friends. Sing songs with musical instruments, bubbles, scarves and etc..

Little Scientist: This is a drop in program for families with children birth to 6 yeas old. Children will explore and discover science activities , they will learn the materials that we are using during the activity and develop their language skills

Let’s Learn Letters: This is a Drop in program for families with children ages birth to 6 years old. Children will learn each week a letter and to activities based on that letter . They will explore and develop activities on fine motor, sensory, cognitive and language throughout the day. This program will enhance children's social and communication skills.

Word Building: This is a drop in program for children aged 4 - 5 years old and that will incorporate various activities to assist in the development of phonic, vocabulary, spelling, writing skills.

Fun with Words: This is a drop in program for children aged 5 - 6 years old and that will incorporate various activities to assist in the development of phonic, vocabulary, spelling, reading and writing skills.

Together Time: This is a program for children and families, to play and learn together. This is a family oriented program fill with fun activities. we play board games, sing songs , dance to the music and have fun together. Children will learn through play with toys, activities and friends.

Ready to Learn Language: A drop in program created for children ages 2-6 years old and their parents/ caregivers. It is a communication, language and literacy based program that focuses on specific domains and skills

Mornelle: PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Tiny Toddlers: This drop in program is for children ages 18 months to 2.6 years old. The toddlers will learn and explore fine motor, cognitive, sensory skills through out the play. They also do creative activities to enhance their imagination skills.

Explore with Numbers: This is a drop in program for families with children ages birth to 6 years old. Children will learn number recognition through art, cognitive, sensory and language activities. Each week they will focus on a number and explore activities and develop their math skills.

Family Fun Time: Children will and play with fun games, board games, engage in family learning together by creating art and craft, cognitive activities, circle time, language activities, children's songs and dance to music. This is a fun filled program for children and families to participate in various learning activities.

Mornelle: ADULT SERVICES

The Value of Play Workshop: The goal of this workshop is to provide information to parents about the benefits of play. Parents will learn how play skills develop, as well as the different stages of play from birth to school. Learning through play will also be discussed. Handouts will be provided.

Helping Children Deal with Anger Workshop: In this workshop, parents will explore the profile of an angry child, including causes of anger, warning signs and anger 'triggers.' The importance of addressing a child's anger will also be discussed and parents will learn some effective strategies that can help children cope with and control anger. Parents will also have the opportunity to view a video and brainstorm ideas through interactive discussion. Informative handouts included.

Together Time: Together Time is an interactive DROP IN in person program on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays 9:00am and Mondays and Wednesdays1:30pm for parents/caregivers with children (0-6yrs). Daily creative activities and various learning centers are available for children to learn from, as well as music circle, finger plays and listening to a story.

Family Math Fun: This is an in person interactive DROP-IN program on Tuesdays at 1:30 p.m. for parents and caregivers with children 2– 6 years old. Families will participate in activities that will help children build their number and number recognition skills through creative activities. Staff, parents and children will participate in circle time session.

Let’s Learn Together: This is an in person DROP-IN interactive program for parents/caregivers and their children birth to 6 years old, on Thursdays at 1:30pm. Children and parents will engage in various activities such as arts and crafts, interactive games, finger plays and music circles.
