This program gives families an opportunity to play in a safe and engaging environment to explore and learn through play. Parents and caregivers can connect with others for social and community support. Program staff will lead circle time at the end.

**Babies at Play:** This is a interactive program for families with children ages birth to 18 months. Baby toys and sensory activities will be provided along with songs and finger plays to stimulate and enhance your baby's development.
