Program Responsibilities:

- Develop creative methods to coach participants with various skill levels and learning needs
- Set up mini-tournaments or games for participants to use their skills

- Engage program participants and use resources within the agency to assist with the needs of the participants
- Consistently collaborate with team members by sharing ideas and differences openly
- Other duties as assigned
