## Orchard Park: PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

**Reading Partnership for Parents (RPP)** : is a 10-week virtual\* play-based program that guides parents through the process of teaching their children (ages 4 to 6) to read. It equips them with the skills, tools and confidence to improve their children's literacy levels by fostering positive reading and learning environments at home.
