RAISE THE GRADE

is an innovative, community based, multi-faceted educational program that aims to increase academic skills, high school graduation rates, and access to post-secondary education/training for youth. The program recognizes the variety of barriers that youth face as they navigate through the educational system and offers academic support, postsecondary and career discovery, along with opportunities to use technology and quality online resources in a supportive environment. The program focuses on a student's transition from grade 7 to post-secondary education/training.



PROGRAMS



consists of virtual programs that are geared towards increasing youth exposure to digital skills, coding concepts, internet safety, and computational thinking through community-based programs. These programs use a combination of facilitated and self-led experiences, as well as digital tools to give children and youth a safe space to explore their creativity. Programs include Kid Tech Nation which teaches children digital skills, coding concepts, internet safety, and computational thinking.
