Orchard Park: PROGRAM DESCRIPTIONS

Together Time: This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Various learning centers, table activities, and toys are available to explore. Staff are available to provide information regarding your child's development, parenting information, community resources and more. Program staff will lead a circle time at the end.

Music Makers: This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Families are invited to join this music circle and participate in new and familiar songs & rhymes.

Friends at Play: This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. This program gives children and caregivers a chance to explore the toys in the program room. Caregivers are encouraged to play with their child

Cognitive Toddlers: This is an interactive program for families with children ages 18 to 30 months. This program focuses on providing opportunities to learn through play and promotes cognitive, language and social development.

Gym Time: This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. The gym is set up with toys to promote gross motor development.

Rainbow Fun: This is a interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Children and their caregivers will be encouraged to participate in gross motor games, songs and activities.

Reading Partnership for Parents (RPP) : is a 10-week virtual* play-based program that guides parents through the process of teaching their children (ages 4 to 6) to read. It equips them with the skills, tools and confidence to improve their children's literacy levels by fostering positive reading and learning environments at home. Participating families receive over \$200 worth of learning tools and resources. *You will need a device that connects to the internet, as well as a microphone and camera to participate in the program.

Parent Consultation: is an opportunity for parents and caregivers to meet one to one with a Community Child Therapist to discuss questions and concerns regarding their child's development, behaviour and routines. Please note that the consultations will be done virtually through the Zoom app. The Zoom details will be emailed to you once your booking has been completed.

Let's Talk About...Toileting: In this workshop, a Community Child Therapist from Strides Toronto will halp parents get through this important milestone by providing toilet training tips that will set their child up for success! Register now to learn the signs of readiness, how to create toilet training schedule and how to access helpful resources that will boost your child's interest to potty train. Limited spots available.
