Rainbow Fun: This is a interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. Children and their caregivers will be encouraged to participate in gross motor games, songs and activities.

Play, Learn & Connect: An interactive program for families with children ages birth to 6. This program gives families an opportunity to play in a safe and engaging environment to explore and learn through play. Parents and caregivers can connect with others for social and community support. Program staff will lead circle time at the end.

Babies at Play: This is a interactive program for families with children ages birth to 18 months. Baby toys and sensory activities will be provided along with songs and finger plays to stimulate and enhance your baby's development.

Baby Music:This is an interactive program for families with children ages birth to 18 months. Families with babies will gather together and sing songs, learn rhymes and use a variety of props and materials.

Workshop: Infant Massage is a 6-week workshop where parents or caregivers will learn the best practices to massage their baby (0-12 months). This workshop is facilitated by students from the Centennial College Massage Therapy Program under the direction of a Registered Massage Therapist (RMT).

Workshop: Behaviour & Positive Discipline is a workshop where parents could gain insight on the cause of many common childhood behaviours and learn effective strategies for preventing their occurrence.

Reading Partnership for Parents Online Program is a 10-week virtual play-based program that guides parents through the process of teaching their children (ages 4 to 6) to read. It equips them with the skills, tools and confidence to improve their children's literacy levels by fostering positive reading and learning environments at home.
